Volunteers packaged dehydrated, fortified rice-soy meals containing over 20 vitamins and minerals especially formulated for the undernourished. The Thirty Pieces of Silver offering will go for this ministry. We are short of our goal to provide the 10,000 meals at 25 cents per meal bag. It is not too late to turn in your Thirty Pieces of Silver offering or to give an additional offering if you feel so led. Small amounts add up to a life giving ministry. If 74 members give 25 cents for three meals a day during a two week time frame (\$10.50), our goal will be reached.
