- Meal costs will be your responsibility.

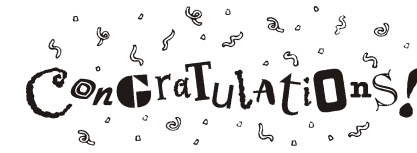
